Submission of Fee

The successful candidates will get their Fee Challans from Fee Section Office within the due date and they must deposit their fee to The Bank of Punjab located within the campus. No Challan Form will be issued after the due date.

Admission on Reserved Seats

Matric and O Level candidates applying for admission on Reserved Seats shall have to take part in trials / interviews as per following scheduled:

1-Sports

Applicants who have won awards for participation in inter-school, district, provincial or national sports events can apply for these seats. Applicants applying for sports seats must attach certificates indicating the same. Admission on sports basis will only be offered to the candidates in the subjects of General Science, ICS Stat, ICS Physics, I.COM & Humanities Group.

Note for Sports Candidates:

- Candidates are required to bring their sports equipment with them for the trials.
- All candidates must present in Sports Ground for the trials at 9:00 am sharp till 4:00 pm evening.
- All Candidates must appear for the interview and they are required to bring their original certificates of participation and awards won at district, provincial and national sports events.

2-Extra-Curricular

Candidates who have participated in inter-school, district, provincial or national Qirat, Naat, debates, drama, singing competitions or have expertise to play a musical instrument are eligible for admission on the basis of extra-curricular activities. Candidates must bring their original achievement certificates with them at the time of interview. Certificates that were achieved in Matriculation level will only be considered. No certificate of junior level will be acceptable.

The Co-Curricular Activities interview will be held according to the following schedule:

3-Kinship

Applicants whose grandmother (both paternal and maternal), mother or sister(s) studying in the college or have done their intermediate or graduation from Kinnaird College can apply for admission on the basis of kinship. Candidates, who have applied on kinship category, must provide / attach documentary evidence with their admission application form showing their grandmother, mother or sister(s) studied at Kinnaird College.

5-Provincial Seats

To be eligible, applicants must have obtained their schooling and taken the Board Examination from the province of their domicile. The candidates from the provinces other than Punjab have to route their complete Admission Application Forms for the provincial reserved seats to the College Admission Office through the concerned Provincial Government along with domicile certificates within due date. The candidates must appear for interviews according to the following Schedule:

- Admission in F.A Humanities does not ensure a place in any specific elective subject. Allotment of elective subjects will be decided by concerned departments on the basis of an aptitude test / merit and availability of seats.
- The candidates must bring the receipt / Admission slip at the time of trial or interview.
- No candidate will be allowed in the campus without receipt / Admission slip.
- All candidates must bring their Original documents / certificates at the time of interviews.
- Forms with incomplete information will not be considered.
- Please do not attach / submit original document with the Admission Application Form.
- The candidates who fail to deposit their dues within the due date will forfeit their right to admission.
- College Authorities have the right to cancel the admission at any stage after the admission, when it comes to their knowledge that the documents presented by the student are fake or there is a misstatement or an error in the documents which may affect her merit.
- All applicants are advised to apply simultaneously to other colleges as seats are limited at Kinnaird.
